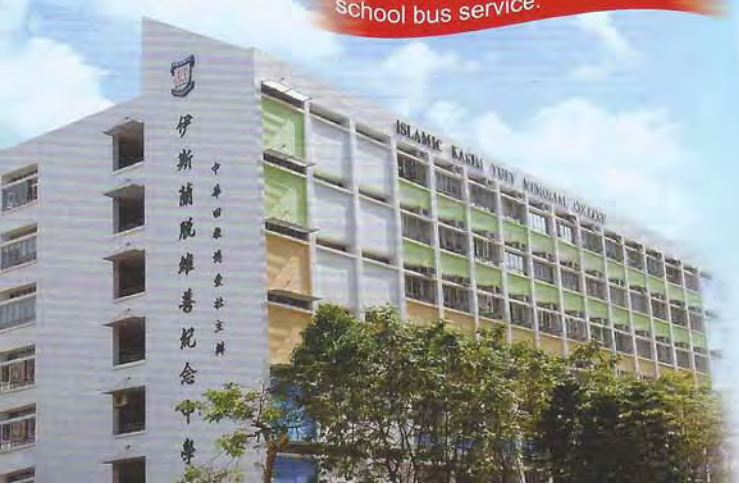

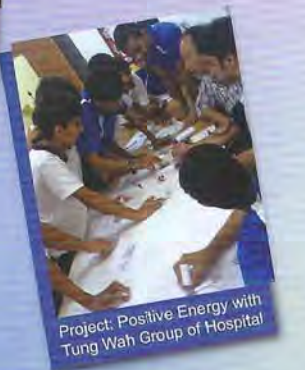

This year, aside from the organization of regular morning assemblies and school assemblies to remind students of the importance of self-respect and respecting others, the committee has also held a number of activities both within and outside school, including: anti-drug scheme, visit to the North Point Police Station, visit to the Police Tactical Unit School Graduation Ceremony and Youth Outreach Student Leaders Training etc, to assist them in building up self-confidence and a proactive life-style.

The committee also organized teacher-student activities, for instance, friendly matches in ball games and talent contests to foster their relationships.

### Joint School Staff Development

Islamic Primary School, Islamic Dharwood Pau Memorial Primary School and our College once again participated in the joint-school staff development day on Sept 7, 2012. It included a talk on 'Enhancing Reading Habits and Skills' by Mr Abbasi, an advisory teacher at the NET Section of the EDB, and a presentation entitled 'Islam in Hong Kong' by Mr Yusuf Yu, our former principal. Moreover, our colleagues arranged professional sharing sessions and recreational activities to facilitate interaction among teachers of the three sister-schools.

## Learning and Teaching

We have a professional & multi-cultural faculty. Our teachers and staff are from different backgrounds including local Chinese, Turkish, Pakistani, Filipino, Nepalese, Canadian and Arab.

In order to ensure good teaching quality, the Principal, the two vice-Principals and the Panel Conveners regularly carry out lesson observation for all the teachers and inspection of students' assignments.

In addition to Chinese and English, our college also provides Arabic, Urdu, Nepali and Putonghua language classes for junior form students who come from different countries.

In addition to School Report Cards, our colleges also prepared Uniform Test Report Cards for the parents to ensure that parents could have a better understanding about the learning progress of their children.

Students excelling in uniform tests or examinations would be selected as "Star of the Year".

Our college organizes "Morning Reading Programme" and "the Library Reading Star Contest" to help students develop a good reading habit and to encourage students to read more books.



Students who are weak in Mathematics or English attended tutorial classes after school for one and a half hours two days a week.

In order to cater for different learning needs of our students, the college adopt (1) recruit extra teacher assistant, (2) invite professionals such as speech therapy and educational psychologists to come to school, (3) arrange tutorial after school, (4) adjusting the syllabuses and (5) adjusting the appraisal methods.

### Chinese Language

#### GCSE / GCE(AS) (Chinese) Examination

Our school has been registered as a sub-center of GCSE Examination for the Chinese Language examination. Last year, we had 76 students attended the GCSE (Chinese). More than 80% of the students got pass, 25% of them achieved A or A\*, 10% got B. In addition, 8 students sat in the GCE (Chinese). Passing rate for Paper 1 has 100%, in which 90% of the students got A or B; as for Paper 2, 90% of them pass and 25% got A. The results were encouraging.

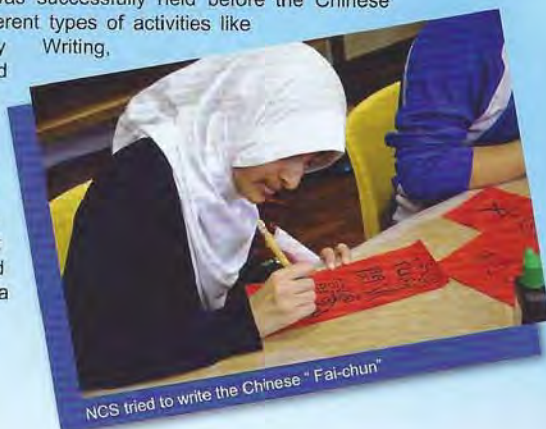

#### HKU cooperative programmes

We launched two cooperative programmes with HKU this year, University Support Programme (USP) and Student Support Programme (SSP). The first one included Form 2 "Picture Book Teaching" and Form 5 Writing programme, both aimed at arousing students' interest in learning Chinese. The second one is the Student Support Programme, whereby after school tutorial lessons are provided for those newly-arrived students or those weak in Chinese Language.

#### Chinese Week

The Chinese Week was successfully held before the Chinese Lunar New Year. Different types of activities like Chinese Calligraphy Writing, Tasting Chinese Food Stall were organized and students enjoyed the happy atmosphere of Chinese New Year in school. Moreover, the Chinese department and DCC co-organized a visit to the Victoria Park New Year Fair.

## Speech Festival

In the 64th Speech Festival, 13 students got 80 marks or above, and attained the merit award and 4 students got the proficiency award.

## Professional Training

In order to further enhance our teachers' leadership skill and teaching effectiveness, our Principal, Ms Zareenah together with the Panel Convener Ms Lo Sau Chu and Assistant Panel Convener Mr. Chan Chun Wah attended a 5-week professional training on "Effective Lesson Observation and Lesson Evaluation" organized by the HKIED in April – May 2013.

## English Language

### Speech Festival

40 entries were made for the Hong Kong Schools Speech Festival. All participants have displayed zealotness and talent. 22 students were awarded Certificate of Merit. 8 Students were awarded Certificate of Proficiency.

### Workshops for students

In September, a workshop "Learning Creative Writing from the Quran" was jointly organized by the English Department and the Islamic Affair Committee for S4 students.

The speaker, Ms Atiys Bansal, taught students how to appreciate the stories from the Quran. Through reading the stories, students have a greater understanding of the concepts of narration, theme, setting, characters, plot and conflict. Students found the workshop stimulating and interesting. Around 100 teachers and students attended the workshops.

### Phonics class for S1 students

A 9-session phonics workshop was organized for S.1 students. Through activities to strengthen students' ability to link letters to sounds, the phonics workshop has boosted students' confidence in reading, spelling and raised their awareness of accurate pronunciation.

### On-line programme

English Builder is an interactive online learning tool. It has been introduced in our school for five years to help students learning English in a fun and easy way.

### English week activities and lunch time activities

Every Tuesdays and Thursdays, the English Room is open for activities. Students watch movies, play Scrabble and other board games, read books and some students get help with English homework or practice their English speaking skills.

During the English weeks, we held different kinds of competitions for students. There were scrabble competitions, tongue twister competitions, a Scavenger Hunt, an essay competition, a Spelling Bee, music show, a book review competition and a campaign to encourage students to speak English.

## Mathematics

A number of specific teaching plans and activities were carried out this school year. They were as follows:

### Teaching strategy

- In order to cater for learning diversity, small class teaching is adopted in teaching Mathematics.
- Students were placed into different classes as according to their ability and development stage in Mathematics.
- For S1 to S3, remedial classes were provided after school twice a week for needed students
- For S4 to S6, remedial and enhancement classes were provided.
- To cater for the individual needs, extra tailor-made learning materials and worksheets were designed for our students.

### Activities Provided

- The talented and outstanding students were selected to participate in different Maths competitions e.g. 3 students were selected recently to attend the World Maths Day, 2 of them achieved Distinction in it and 1 got participation award.
- Maths & Science Week was held so as to arouse the students' interest and to help them to gain more practical experiences.



## Liberal Studies

We have continued participating in the school based support programme organized by the Education Bureau, by having regular professional exchange with the Liberal Studies Team of St. Clare's Girls' School, in various areas such as curriculum development. We have taken some students to pay visits to their lessons to adopt possible teaching and learning strategies.

To facilitate our S6 students to get better grades in HKDSE, we have also arranged frequent and intensive tutorials, and it has received positive response from our enthusiastic and diligent students.

Furthermore, to assist our students to have a good grasp of key themes and issues in the subject, and to strengthen their exam skills, our team has dedicated lots of time to edit a 300-pages of notes. We have also designed and revised school-based materials from time to time so as to facilitate teaching and learning of most of the topics.

Last but not least, we have also arranged various activities outside the classroom, hoping students can take Liberal Studies as a subject closely related to their daily life, and develop the habit of paying attention to what's happening in society.

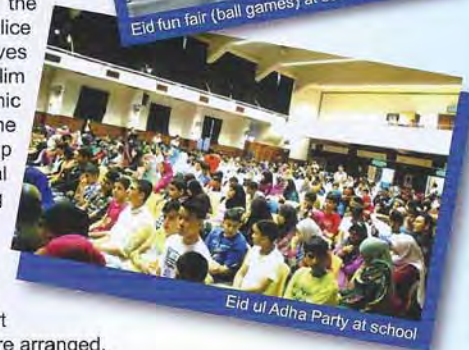

- A series of workshop on JUPAS and EAPP were delivered to the S6 students since October, 2012. Representatives of different institutes and alumni of our school were invited to give updated information on further studies to our current students.
- Our College was invited by the TST police station to recommend some S5 and S6 students to attend a Chinese Language program on every Saturdays. The aim of the program is to further improve the students' Chinese proficiency and to prepare them to sit for the Chinese Language Exam by the Government, so that, they will have higher chances to join the police force or other Government Departments.



## Co-curricular Activities

Whole person development has always been a major focus of the College's curriculum. We aim at encouraging students to develop and explore diversified interests and cultivate different hobbies, in which their potentials can be maximized. More than 50 interest groups and clubs are set up this year, covering several major categories, namely academic, community service, aesthetics, multi-media, interest groups, sports and foreign languages.

Moreover, more visitors from different countries visited our schools in recent years, which included visitors from UK, Thailand, Indonesia, China and Arab countries.

Through Exchange programs, we have more understanding about each others' education systems and build good networking. These programs open more opportunities for our students to further their studies in overseas universities or higher institutions.

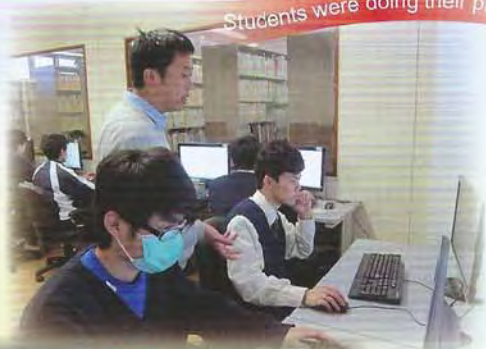
