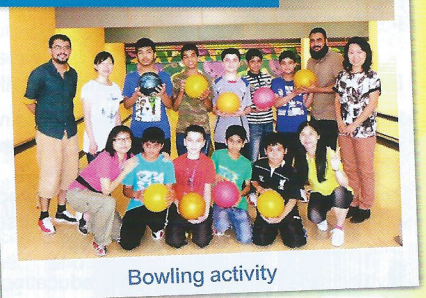

## Joint School Staff Development

Islamic Primary School, Islamic Dhawood Pau Memorial Primary School and our College once again organized the joint-school development day on Sept 6, 2013. It included a workshop on "Happy at work" conducted by a social worker. Our colleagues arranged professional sharing sessions on how to teach Chinese to Non-Chinese students (NCS). In addition, some recreational activities were conducted to facilitate interaction among teachers of the three schools.

## Learning and Teaching

In addition to Chinese and English languages, our College also provides Arabic, Urdu and Nepali languages as elective subjects for the junior form students who come from different countries.

In addition to School Report Cards, our College has also issued Uniform Test Report Cards so parents can have a better understanding of the learning progress of their children. Teachers and parents can discuss students' academic performances and personal development on the two Parents' Days.

Students who have excellent results in uniform tests or examinations will be selected as "Star of the Year" and their names and photos will be shown in the school board of "Star of the Year".

In this academic year, S6 classes started in mid-August so that both teachers and students had more time to prepare for the HKDSE. The responses from the students were positive.

This year, we have some new arrangements during the uniform test periods, (i) no lessons during the periods, (ii) conduct revision lessons before tests. It is hoped that students can have more time to prepare for the tests and they can achieve better results from tests. It is noted that students' results have improved greatly.

"Morning Reading Programme" has been arranged for all students during class teacher period every Monday and Wednesday morning. This aims at cultivating students' reading habit and arousing their awareness of current issues. Moreover, the school librarian and the English teachers have jointly organized "the Library Reading Star Contest" to encourage students to read more books. E-books are also available on our school website now.

Students who need extra support in Mathematics or English have been requested to attend tutorial classes twice a week after school. Each session lasts for one and a half hours. Moreover, an after school homework remedial class has been arranged for Chinese students and newly arrived students of the junior form every day.

Our College also organized many activities during the English Week, Chinese Week, Mathematics and Science Week, Liberal Studies Week, Life Wide Learning Day, etc. Different activities and competitions help our students broaden their horizons and enhance their learning effectiveness. Moreover, Chinese speaking and non-Chinese speaking students can also have more chances to interact and learn from one another.

To cater for diverse learning needs of our students, we have implemented the following measures:

- Employing extra teacher assistants;
- In order to enhance teachers' understanding of integrated education, we had sent teachers to attend different courses and arranged experience-sharing sessions to build up teachers' professional capability. 11% of our teachers completed the basic training course, 3 teachers completed the advanced course and 2 teachers completed thematic course (in 3 of the 8 areas);
- Inviting speech therapist and educational psychologists to provide service for our students;
- Offering after school tutorials;
- Adjusting the syllabuses;
- Using different assessment methods;
- Enlarging words of the learning materials, test papers and examination paper for students with special needs.



## Chinese Language

### GCSE / GCE(AS) Examination

Last year, 93 students sat for the General Certificate of Secondary Education (GCSE) Chinese Examination, more than 80% of students passed, 34% of them achieved A\* or A, 29% got B or C. Moreover, in Paper 2 Speaking, Paper 3 Reading and Paper 4 Writing, 40% of students got A\* or A in each paper. In addition, 4 students sat for the General Certificate of Education (GCE) Exams in AS Level Chinese last year and the passing rate is 100%. 1 student got A as the overall grade.

### HKU cooperative programmes

We launched the University-School Support Programme with HKU this year. Through this programme, we have become a seeded school and are able to get more resources for teaching Non-Chinese students.

### Chinese Week

Chinese Week was held before the Chinese Lunar New Year holidays.

Teachers organized different activities in the school such as Chinese Mask Drawing, Chinese Calligraphy and Chinese Food Stall in the school so that students could enjoy the festive atmosphere of Chinese New Year.

Moreover, all the S.1 students were arranged to visit the Victoria Park New Year Fair. 20 students attended the "2014 Let's Enjoy Cantonese Opera in Bamboo Theatre" on January 22, 2014 and this has provided them with a chance to enjoy traditional Cantonese Opera in a traditional bamboo theatre.

# English Language

## Speech Festival

46 students have taken part in the 65th Hong Kong Schools Speech Festival. All participants have demonstrated enthusiasm and talent. Due to the intensive coaching by teachers and hard work of students, we have got impressive results. One student came second, 33 students obtained Certificate of Merit and 10 students were awarded Certificate of Proficiency.

## Workshops for students

Funded by the English Language Enhancement Scheme, workshops on critical thinking and writing skills for S4 and S5 students were held respectively. The workshops were conducted by specialists from English for Asia and conducted during regular lessons over a period of 7 weeks in each term. Students have learned to read more effectively with a critical mind, as well as to structure their writing in a more coherent and logical manner. They have acquired vital skills for writing essays.

English Builder is the online learning programme for our students. It aims at helping students to improve their English at their own pace. Students find the exercises interesting and engaging.

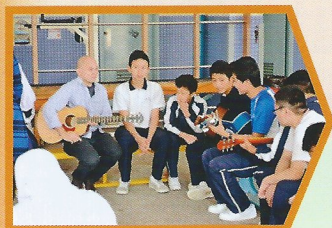

# Mathematics

A number of specific teaching plans and activities were carried out this school year. They were as follows:

## Teaching strategies

- In order to cater for the student learning diversity, the classes were divided into a number of small groups, so that both teaching and learning can be more effective. Students were put into different classes according to their abilities and standards.
- Extra tailor-made learning materials and worksheets were designed to cater for needs of individual students.
- For S1 to S3, English and Chinese are used as the medium of instruction.
- For S4 to S6, remedial and enhancement classes were offered.
- Pre-exam revision classes for S6 Students were conducted.

# Liberal Studies

## Cross-subject Collaboration

With the assistance of the Education Bureau officers specialized in teaching English in a Cross-subject manner, Cross-subject collaboration in S1 between the English and Liberal Studies Departments was implemented this school year so as to enable students to master the way of English frequently used in Social Science and increase teachers' understanding of the requirements of both subjects.

## Professional Exchange

We have continued participating in the school-based support programme organized by the Education Bureau by having regular professional exchange with the Liberal Studies Team of St. Clare's Girls' School. Our colleagues have also observed their lessons and exchanged experiences with other teachers.

To help our S6 students get better grades in HKDSE, we have arranged intensive tutorials on Saturday mornings. Many enthusiastic and diligent students have attended.



## School-based L.S. Materials

Furthermore, to ensure that our students have a good grasp of key themes and issues and to strengthen their exam skills, we have prepared a lot of materials for them to do revision. We also revised school-based materials from time to time so as to facilitate teaching and learning.

## Out-of-school Learning

- Last but not least, we have also arranged various activities outside the classroom. For instance, we have invited a script writer of the Hong Kong Television Network to share his opinions on recent issues. We hope students can take Liberal Studies as a subject closely related to their daily life and develop the habit of paying attention to what is happening in society.
- IKTMC Liberal Studies Forum is open in the Facebook in order to encourage teachers and students to have more sharing and discussions on current issues. Responses from both teachers and students are positive and encouraging.

## Moral and Civic Education

Students' characters and mental development are always our concern. We have organized various activities to boost students' confidence and help them become civic minded citizens. The following activities were organized:

- Flag selling for the Chai Wan Kaifong Welfare Association.
- Visit to the Legislative Council.
- Visit to the Oxfam Education center. Students learnt about topics such as fair trade and global income disparity through interesting activities.

## Careers & Guidance

➤ In order to give students more information about further studies and career path planning, the Career Guidance Teachers organized a series of activities at the end of November 2013. There were information booths, movie and game stalls during lunch time and school talks given by professionals from tertiary institutes and government departments.

➤ The Career Guidance Committee always encourages students to search for multi-pathways in equipping themselves before joining the workforce. The VTC Open Day in early December 2013 served as a platform for our students to look for sub-degree courses that pave the way to future career development.

### Workplace visits

To prepare our S6 students for the big challenges ahead, the committee organized various visits to different workplaces so as to expose them to different job opportunities and job requirements in both private and public sectors.

### Child Development Fund

This year, our College has undertaken a 3-year project called "Child Development Fund" organized by the Labour and Welfare Bureau. The objectives of the Project are to encourage students to plan for the future, develop an asset-building habit as well as accumulate savings and intangible assets (such as positive attitudes, personal resilience and social networks). We have organized a Wealth Management Workshop, Personal and Career Development Workshop, Multi-media Workshop and some field trips for students. Besides, there are also some programmes for parents and mentors.

### Scholarships for graduates

Our committee keeps close contact with graduates and tries to assist them to get scholarships when their academic performances are outstanding. This year, Misbah Munir got a scholarship granted by Federation of Hong Kong Guangdong Community Organisations as a successful candidate of HKDSE. Chan Teck Fai Saputra also got 50% scholarship in studying a Bachelor degree in Industrial Engineering at Istanbul Aydin University. Due to his outstanding performance, the University is going to offer 1 full scholarship to one of our S6 graduates in 2014/2015.



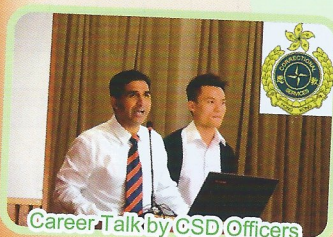

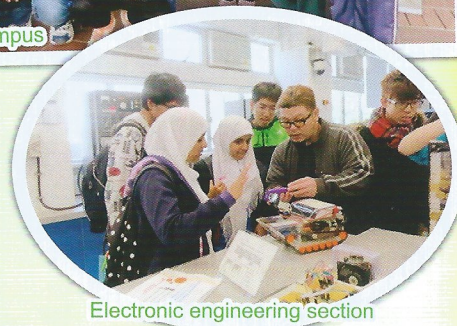

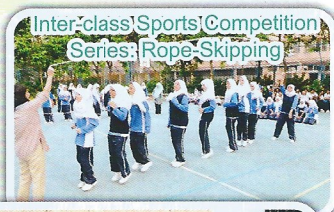
## Co-curricular Activities

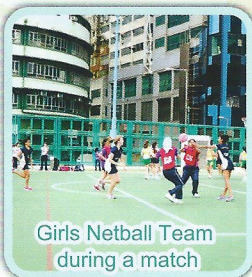

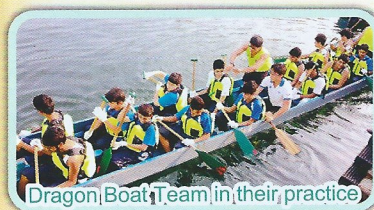

### School Teams

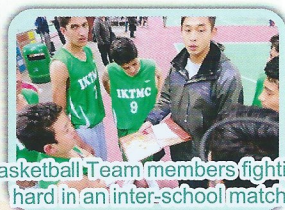

### Community Service and Voluntary Team

To give students opportunities to know more about the people of different social strata and gain more self-confidence, we encouraged volunteering so that students could render their services to the community.
