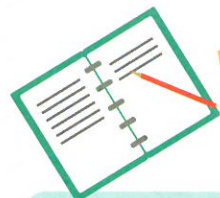

# Chinese Language

## GCSE / GCE(AS) Examination

Last year, 81 students sat for the General Certificate of Secondary Education (GCSE) Chinese Exams., more than 70% of students got pass, around 30% of them achieved A\* or A. Moreover, in Paper 1 Listening more than 50% of students got A\* or A in each of the paper; while in Paper 3 Reading, 45% of them got A\* or A. In addition, 3 students attended the General Certificate of Education (GCE) Exams in AS Level Chinese last year, all of them got overall grade B.

## Co-operation programmes with outsiders

The Chinese Panel joined a support programme launched by the Education Bureau (EDB) Language Learning Support Section, by having regular meetings with the supporting teacher from EDB; we try out some new teaching plans in lessons.

In addition, we had joined the Student Support Programme, teachers from the University of Hong Kong conducted a GCSE class and a new arrival class after school every week.

## Chinese Week

Chinese Week was successfully held before the Chinese Lunar New Year; teachers in the panel had organized different types of activities like Chinese Comic Writing Competition, Chinese Penmanship Competition, Chinese Mask Drawing, Chinese Calligraphy, Chinese Food Stall, Chinese Tongue Twister Competition and Chinese programme broadcast. The Chinese department also arranged S1 and new arrival students a visit to the Victoria Park New Year Fair to taste the joyful atmosphere of the Chinese New Year.



## Outside school activities

6A Hajrah Akhtar had participated in the Work place Chinese language programme for Non-Chinese Speaking (NCS) students lunched by the Department of Chinese and Bilingual Studies and the School of Professional Education and Executive Development of The Hong Kong Polytechnic University during 2015 summer. She got Level 1 of Qualifications Framework in Chinese practical writing.

This year 22 students participated in the 67th Speech Festival and gained a pleasant result. 7 students got the merit award and 7 students got the proficiency award. Details please refer to Page 11.

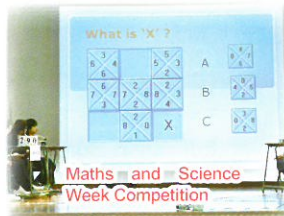
## Mathematics

A number of specific teaching plans and activities were carried out this school year. They were as follows:

### (A) Teaching strategy

To cater for learners' diversities

- Students were allocated into different small classes according to their ability and development stage in Mathematics. This is to facilitate smooth learning progress and cater for learner diversity.
- In S. 4 to 6, remedial and enhancement classes were provided after school.
- Extra tailor-made learning materials and worksheets have been designed for our students.
- In this year, we invited some more able junior students to participate in designing teaching materials on "Congruence and Similarity" and senior forms more able students on "Trigonometry ratio". Through exploration and design, students would be able to develop a deeper understanding of mathematical concepts and they can benefit at the cognitive level by carrying out practical application of concepts of mathematics.



### (B) Activities organised

- Maths & Science Week was held so as to arouse the students' interest and to help them gain more practical experiences.
- In order to develop student's self-confidence, we held competition on different topics of the Mathematics curriculum.

## Liberal Studies

Just like the past, Liberal Studies has continued its previous effective measures to facilitate our students.

We have continued our participation in a platform called 'Schools Using English as a Medium of Instruction to teach Liberal Studies' organized by the Education Bureau. Meanwhile, we have started professional interaction with St. Clare's Girls' College.

To facilitate S.6 students to get better grades, apart from the Saturday morning tutorials, we have arranged all of them to attend examination skill sessions, and our teachers have focused on various exam question types and the essential writing skills.

We have also tried very hard to make class vivid and interesting by arranging debate activities, attending interactive workshop and sharing from alumni.

Last but not least, the teacher-student debate during Liberal Studies Week could have been a good chance for disciples to outshine their teachers. However, the teachers' team brilliant, humorous and charismatic performance has won a big hand from the students and therefore they were victorious.
