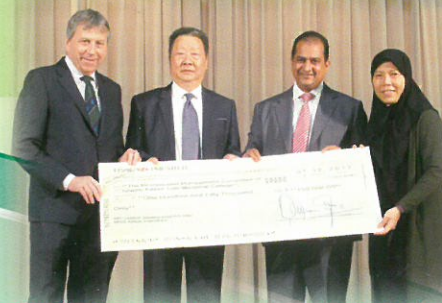

- Cultural activities have been organized to enhance mutual understanding and appreciation.

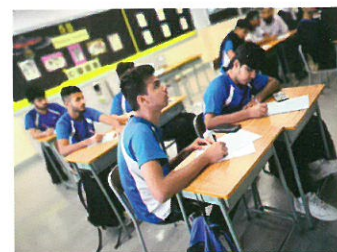


Whole-school Language Policy

- Chinese and English Languages are the official languages used as the medium of instruction in teaching and learning and daily communication in the school campus;
- Elective Languages such as Arabic, Urdu, Nepali and Putonghua languages are offered.

Strategies used in catering learning needs

- Small class size with good teacher-student ratio;
- Chinese and Mathematics lessons are assigned to students based on their abilities;
- Extra tailor-made learning materials and worksheets are designed by different subject teachers in assisting students with different learning needs facilitate learning;
- For junior form students, enhancement classes are arranged after school to improve their performance in English, Chinese and/or Mathematics;
- For senior form students, in order to boost their results in the public examination, HKDSE, extra lessons for different subjects are arranged during school days, weekends and school holidays;
- Tailor-made bridging program is designed for new arrival students.

E-Learning

- In order to encourage students to learn more eagerly and actively, we have purchased more mobile learning tools such as i-pads and tablets to facilitate teaching and learning inside and outside school;
- Computers in the library and computer room were upgraded; and

Our college prepares different Chinese Curricula to help students prepare for different public Chinese Examinations including HKDSE, IGCSE, GCE (AS) and GCE (AL).

Last year, our students achieved outstanding results especially in the General Certificate of Secondary Education (GCSE) Examination, summary as follows:

- 97 students attempted the GCSE Chinese Exams
- Overall papers : 25% of them achieved A* or A
- Listening paper : 60% of students got A* or A
- Reading and Writing papers : more than 30% of them got A* or A

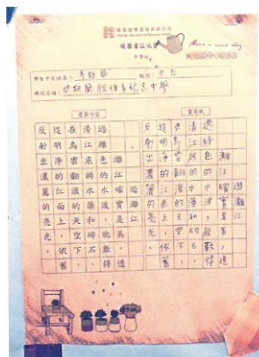

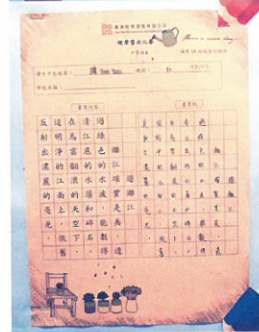

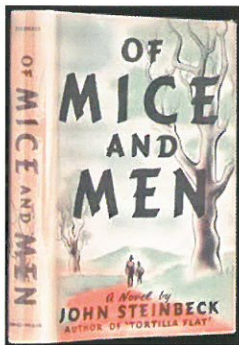

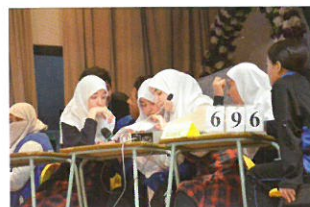
The major aim is to organize various activities to stimulate students' interest in studying Liberal Studies.
