Dear Parents/Guardians,

Please be informed that April 21 (Friday) & 24 (Monday), 2023 will be Eid-ul-Fitr holiday. April 25, 2023 (Tuesday) will be an Eid-celebration day. There will be a Quran recitation competition, an Imam's talk, a Nasheed performance and a class party.

In addition, we would like to dedicate that day as a Casual cum Cultural Wear Day in order to raise funds for the needy. Your support will be highly appreciated. Please encourage your child to support in this meaningful activity.

Details for wearing casual/cultural wear are as follows:

1. A donation of not less than \$20 is required for student who wear casual/cultural wear. Student can also put on school uniform.
2. Dress code for the day:
 - a) Apart from the casual/cultural wear, participants are required to abide by the school rules governing their appearance (for example, dyeing hair, make up, henna are not allowed);
 - b) The attire must be suitable for students and must not attract undue attention:
 - Revealing or weird clothing is not allowed;
 - Punk trousers and clothes are not allowed;
 - Skirts are not allowed;
 - Muslim girls have to put on scarf, top with full sleeves;
 - No high heels
3. The donation must be given to the Donation box on the Eid-Celebration Day (April 25, 2023).
4. Students who fail to observe the above regulations will be dealt with accordingly. It's a regular school day and attendance is compulsory.

Students must reach school before 8:00 a.m. The school dismissal will be at 12:00 noon on that day. School buses will leave at 12:15 pm.
