

Annual Athletic Meet (2022-2023) Student Regulations

A. General Regulations:

1. Students must wear school uniform or school P.E. uniform and sports shoes. Accessories, make up, nail polishing and dyed hair are strictly prohibited.
2. Students are not allowed to bring any audio / visual devices or other gadgets, magazines or any items that are not related to the sports days. Students who failed to observe these regulations will be punished and such items will be confiscated immediately.
3. All mobile phones must be switched off. Students are not allowed to use mobile phones inside the sports ground area. They are compulsory to submit the mobile phones to DCC.
4. Students are required to arrive at the Wan Chai sports ground before 8:10 a.m.
5. Late-comers and students with improper uniform will be punished. No alternations will be entertained for those failed to attend the events on this behalf.
6. Students should pay attention to the weather report before they leave home. If No. 1, or other typhoon signals, or amber rainstorm signal is hoisted, the sports day will be cancelled. Students will have regular lessons according to the time table.
7. If No. 8 typhoon signal, red or black rainstorm signal is hoisted, the sports day will be cancelled. Students do not have to go to school.
8. If students are not feeling well on that day, please contact the school office on or before 8:20 a.m. (Tel. No.: 2570 9066). Students have to submit a medical certificate and a letter from parents to their Class Teacher within one week. Students who failed to do so will be considered as truants.
9. If students need to apply for casual leave, they have to submit their application in advance to **Mr. Ma Wing Cheung**, the vice principal, for approval.
10. All student helpers must wear the “student helper” badge when report to duty.
11. Only the event staff and competitors are allowed to enter the field and track.
12. No students are allowed to enter the areas assigned to other classes.
13. Students can go outside for lunch, bring their own food or order the food from school tuck shop to eat in the sport ground.
14. Students should keep the sports ground clean and tidy. Eating or drinking (including chewing gum) is not allowed in the sports ground area (except tuck shop). Students are expected to behave well during lunch break (e.g. no yelling and littering in the public area).
15. Sports Day is one of the school activities, students are required to follow the school regulations. Misbehaving students will be punished according to the school regulations.

B. Competition Rules

1. All competitors must wear school P.E. uniform.
2. After **the first call**, all competitors must report to the marshal stand with their student cards and label cloth.
3. Students who failed to show their label cloth will not be allowed to participate in any event.
4. HK\$5 will be charged for an extra label cloth.
5. Competitors who entered in both track and field events which start around or at the same time, should first report to the track event and inform the Marshal that about their field event. Competitors are requested to note that the field event will still continue during their absence. If the field event has already finished and the placing of competitors is fixed, competitors who has left the event will forfeit their chance of the said competition.
6. Competitors must return to their class after each event. They are not allowed to hang around or disturb others.
