



Learning and Teaching

Educational Support for Non-Chinese Speaking Students

Our college provides additional support for our non-Chinese speaking students to facilitate their learning of Chinese language: providing after-school support programmes in learning Chinese language; appointing additional teachers to support non-Chinese speaking students' learning of Chinese language; arranging intensive Chinese language learning and teaching mode(s), e.g. An additional Chinese language class is provided in each level to help non-Chinese speaking students learn Chinese language more effectively; developing school-based Chinese language curriculum and adapting learning and teaching materials; organizing cultural integration activities; and hiring additional manpower to do the translation services to facilitate the communication with the non-Chinese speaking parents.

Whole School Approach to Integrated Education

The objective of the whole school approach to integrated education of our college is to provide students with appropriate support in order to cater for learners' diversity so that their potential could be fully developed.

There is a student support team in our college. The team has regular meetings to follow up students' progress. The measures provided by this team include: assessment accommodation, remedial learning groups to enhance their Chinese and English language ability, social skills training groups, speech therapy, and individual education plans for students, etc. Moreover, an education psychologist from the EDB regularly visits our college to provide support services for our students and training seminars for our teachers. The supporting fund is provided by "the Learning Support Grant (LSG) for Secondary Schools."

E-learning

Teachers and students can have different e-learning activities in the classroom with the school wifi and i-Pads. Students show higher motivation and participate more actively in the learning process because i-Pads can bring a greater diversity of learning activities to students. The followings are some examples. Kahoot can give students instant results and feedback. Students can search information immediately from the Internet in class to back up their arguments for their group discussion; some teachers use e-learning apps or platforms such as Quizlet, Nearpod, and E-puzzle in order to arouse students' interest in learning. Due to COVID-19, teachers and students conducted online lessons via Google Meet, and students submitted their assignments with the Google Classroom platform during the school suspension period.

Promotion of Reading

The library department organizes the "Reading Scheme" to encourage students to develop a good reading habit.

In addition to printed library books, students can also read the e-books provided by our school, including e-library plus, Britannica and HKEdcity.

IGCSE & GCE (AS) Examination


Last year, 15 students achieved Level 8 and Level 9 in the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) Chinese Exams. In addition, 6 students got Grade A in the General Certificate of Education (GCE) Exams in AS Level Chinese.

Out-of-school Experience and Achievements

This year, some students participated in different competitions and activities such as the 72nd Speech Festival, writing competition, and penmanship competition which gave them a lot of opportunities to use Chinese in daily practice. Some of them got encouraging results, e.g. F.3 Yang Xiao Jie got a merit prize in a writing competition organized by Ming Pao. Our F.6 students, Shaika Shaida and Lotfifard Zahra, and a F.4 student, Ummar Haryat Khan got the chance to write for Ming Pao in Chinese, to describe their IO years of life in the future. We also helped two F.3 students publish their Chinese writings on an online learning platform.

Professional Development

The Chinese panel has joined a learning community for Chinese language teachers launched by the Education Bureau (EDB) Language Learning Support Section. By having regular meetings, we collaborated in exploring coping strategies and reflected on pedagogical practice.

English Langague

English Speech Festival 2020-2021 Roundup

Our students made remarkable achievements at the 72nd Hong Kong School Speech Festival this year. The majority of our 19 students obtained the certificate of merit or above. The students exhibited a strong sense of responsibility and independent initiative, and were guided closely by their respective English teachers. Despite the COVID-19 pandemic and hence the new format of the competition, the competing students persisted and worked hard on their material. We are very proud of our junior students for obtaining the highest results; Khan Hussain from 3B was awarded second place, and Chowdhury Ahnaf from 1B, and Rahman Md Aniq from 2B were awarded third place in English Solo Verse Speaking.

English Debate Team

This year, the Debate Team was busy preparing for the Hong Kong Secondary Schools Debating Competition (HKSSDC). The debates were all held on Zoom due to the pandemic. While a new format for participants, coaches, and adjudicators, the competition ran quite smoothly, and the students learnt to make full use of their body language when communicating ideas through an online platform. They also learnt to manage their time efficiently and communicate effectively over various platforms since face-to-face meetings were quite limited.

This year, our Debate Team also grew in size with many new members expressing their interest in joining the team thanks to the encouragement of the teachers and our very own seasoned debaters. Together, both old and new members learnt to work as a team, dividing up research work and also actively participating in speaking games and mock debates to brush up their argumentative and public speaking skills. Despite the ongoing pandemic, the students have benefited greatly from working together and participating in the HKSSDC this year.

SCHOLAR English Alliance "From Page to Stage" Programme 2021 - Comedy of Mistakes

Congratulations! We have been awarded an Emerald Medal because it has been the sixth year since IKTMC participated in "From Page to Stage" programme. On 19 March, about a dozen S4 students were taken to see the much-anticipated drama performance, Comedy of Mistakes, adapted from Sherlock Holmes' The Speckled Band.

In this play, the first part is where everything goes wrong on stage with hilarious consequences. This drew laughter! When it all finally went right in the second part, the audience could get a rare glimpse of the diverse aspects of what and whom constitutes a theatre production. English Week

From 31 March until 1 April, 2021, our students showed off their school spirit by taking part in English Week online. Day two saw our students listen to a podcast from BBC Learning English and display their listening comprehension skills. Mathematics

A number of specific teaching plans and activities were carried out in this school year. They were as follows:

Teaching strategy

For the sake of the students' learning effectiveness in priority

Maths classes were divided into a number of small groups with the most appropriate teacher-student ratio in junior and senior forms.

To cater the individual needs

- In order to create a platform in learning mathematics without difficulty and progress smoothly, junior and senior form students were placed into different classes according to their ability and developmental stage in Mathematics.
- · Remedial and enhancement classes were provided
- Extra tailor-made learning materials and worksheets were designed for our students. Therefore, it could facilitate learning effectiveness.

HKDSE preparations for S6 students

- To achieve the value-added goal in HKDSE result, remedial and enhancement strategies were applied in senior forms.
- Special classes were provided for the students after school in order to help our students to get good results.
- To achieve better results in HKDSE, extra classes and concentrated exercises were given during the preparation period for the HKDSE.
- A large number of compulsory questions were offered. Also, a specific target and clear objectives were set to help students develop an awareness of the key issues in the HKDSE questions.
- To enhance the effectiveness of learning, some tailor-made e-learning (video episodes) were provided for students. It makes learning simpler and easier.

Activities Organized

To enhance students' appreciation of Mathematics and to arouse their interest

- To coincide with the school's 50th anniversary, a Mathematics Calculation Puzzle Competition was held to increase students' sensitivity to numbers.
 STEM compass design activities for S3 students were organized to help students build mathematical knowledge and problem-solving ability.
- To enhance students' chances of success and mathematics skills, students participated in different mathematics competitions, such as the 2020 ICAS International Competitions and Assessments for schools.

The purpose of the activities was to train students to apply the concepts of mathematics knowledge in daily life and to enhance students' cognitive development and understanding of mathematics so that students could understand that learning and life are closely related.

To cater for the characteristics of our students

To make provision for characteristics of our students in learning, review and appropriate teaching activities would be given at the beginning of each chapter, with the level focusing on the beginners initially. It stimulates students' motivation, lets students master future study in mathematics learning easily, and creates a relaxing learning atmosphere for those who have a sense of confusion in mathematics.

To make mathematical concepts more tangible

In order to inspire students to participate in learning, different teaching aids were used to symbolize theoretical mathematical concepts. For example, the topics of area and volume, geometry and probability were produced into specific project designs for students to participate in. The department also encouraged the students to master their knowledge and drew their attention to the key points of learning. This could help students transform short-term memories into long-term memories easily.

Liberal Studies

Despite the unpleasant pandemic situation as well as school suspensions, both Liberal Studies Department and Moral and Civic Education Committee collaborated well to offer valuable and eye-opening learning experience to our students.

We have invited researchers from Our Hong Kong Foundation to give us a seminar on Artificial Intelligence. The Form Four students had better understanding about thriving businesses in the near future, such as 5G and Cloud computing.

Last but not least, we have invited the staff from Oxfam Interactive Education Centre to share with us about the worsening contemporary environmental situation, and what we can do as global citizens.



We were delighted to have Bibi Uzma, an IKTMC's brilliant alumna, who shared her university life and overseas exchange experiences with our Form One students during the Liberal Studies Week.

Her overseas experience included exchange trips and study programmes in the United Kingdom, Brazil, and Myanmar. Uzma showed her juniors the marvels and wonders of different cultures and lifestyles across the globe.


