Every student has their own Google account based on school email to login and access Google classroom and Google form. Sharing of notes, online M.C. questions and short question assignment as well as quiz can be conducted through the Google platform easily.
		Reflection: 1. The use of Kahoot may not allow teachers to spot out weaker students. There are some limitations such as word limit and question former. There are only
		are some limitations such as word limit and question format. There are only choice-making questions.
		2. It's not easy to find suitable e-learning resources for NCS learning Chinese

		Language. 3. There were very few or no relevant seminars and workshops related to e-learning that specifically related to some subject matter, e.g. teaching NCS Chinese Language, junior form music. 4. The pre-requisite of successful interactive teaching and learning, including using ipads, is students' serious and mature attitude. Teachers need to be patient and tolerant.
